## Fall Tips

September, October, November

### September

Mow, trim and edge lawn areas.

Prune shrubs as needed

Inspect trees, shrubs and turf for insect and disease. ( Treat as necessary)

Remove faded flower heads from Crape Myrtles.

Apply post-emergent to control weeds as necessary.

Begin aerating, over seeding and fertilizing fescue lawns. (September 15th Weather permitting)

Begin Installation of fall color. (After September 15th Weather permitting)

### October

Mow, trim and edge lawn areas.

Prune shrubs as needed

Inspect trees, shrubs and turf for insect and disease. ( Treat as necessary)

Begin flower maintenance. (Deadheading, fertilization and weeding as necessary)

Begin leaf removal Apply post-emergent to control weeds as necessary.

Complete aerating, over seeding and fertilizing fescue lawns.

Fertilize trees and shrubs with a balanced fertilizer.

Apply pre-emergent to warm season turf. (Control fall and winter weeds)

Continue installation of fall color. Start transplanting shrubs.

Divide perennials such as hosta and daylilies.

### November

Mow, trim and edge lawn areas as needed.

Continue leaf removal.

Begin shut down and winterization of irrigation systems.

Continue flower maintenance. (Deadheading, fertilization and weeding as necessary)

Apply post-emergent to control weeds as necessary.

Apply slow release fertilizer to fescue lawns.

Complete installation of fall color.

Install spring flowering bulbs.

Fall digging season begins. Install balled and burlapped trees and shrubs.

Cut back perennials after 1st frost dieback.
